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A conjunction is a word that joins words, phrases or sentences.

Examples: and, but, or, because, so, though, while, although, if, when, before, after.

Conjunctions are of three kinds:

1. Coordinating Conjunctions: and, but, or, so, because, for, nor, yet
2. Subordinating Conjunctions: when, if, because, although, though, while, before, after, since, until
3. Correlative Conjunctions: either...or, neither...nor, both...and, not only...but also, whether...or
